Grade 7 Up–A silly, sometimes far-fetched, but very readable second book in a fantastical mystery/adventure series about a 20-year-old guy who's leading a double life. By day, PJ is a diligent California college student and part-time graphic artist for a movie studio. At night, as a descendant of Greek gods Perseus and Hercules, he unwillingly battles villainous mythological gods and beasts with Zeus's guidance. Four years after he battled and defeated Medusa, he's again summoned by Zeus to complete Hercules's Twelve Labors. Hercules has been tricked by Atlas into holding up the heavens but is getting weaker and losing control, and PJ must complete the Labors and find Atlas, who's disappeared, before the world collapses. Many familiar Greek mythological characters and deeds are cleverly incorporated into the plot. In between his James Bond-like heroics, complete with magical armaments supplied by Athena, PJ is an ordinary guy who actually studies and attends class regularly while still having time for dating, surfing, and snowboarding. Despite the amateurish-looking cover, this fast-moving, often corny, and sometimes contrived story is oddly compelling with its literary references (PJ is reading Ayn Rand's *Atlas Shrugged* for class), legendary characters, and heroic quests reminiscent of role-playing video games.–*Sharon Rawlins, Piscataway Public Library, NJ* Copyright © Reed Business Information, a division of Reed Elsevier Inc.
